



Virginia Rent Relief **at a glance**



Over \$1 billion

has been disbursed to households in Virginia

193,588

payments have been made in rent relief assistance

The household's total gross income must be equal to or less than 80% of area mean income to qualify. **More than 71%** of those approved had **area median incomes below 30%**.



As of October 2022, all funds have been exhausted. Mortgage and rent relief has been disbursed* through these state and federal resources:

- CARES: **\$62 million**
- Virginia Housing Trust Fund: **\$21 million**
- ERA 1.0: **\$534.6 million**
- ERA 2.0: **\$455.7 million**
