Virginia Board of Housing and Community Development Elects Chairman and Vice Chairman

RICHMOND – The Virginia Board of Housing and Community Development recently elected its chairman and vice chairman of the board.

Anthony Clatterbuck was elected chairman. Clatterbuck is the owner and president of custom homebuilder Graystone Homes Inc., located in Culpeper, Virginia. He has served as a member of the board since 2007 and continues to serve as the chairman of the board's Codes and Standards Committee, which he has done since 2009. Clatterbuck also served as vice chairman of the board since 2010.

John Ainslie was elected vice chairman. Ainslie is the president of construction for the Ainslie Group, a home building company located in Virginia Beach. Ainslie has served as a member of the board since 2010 and formerly served as a member of the State Building Code Technical Review Board. Ainslie also has been appointed this year to serve as the Board of Housing and Community Development representative on the Virginia Fire Services Board.

The Board of Housing and Community Development consists of 14 citizen members, including 11 members appointed by the Governor from each of Virginia's Congressional Districts, a representative from the Virginia Fire Services Board appointed by the chairman of that board, the executive director of the Virginia Housing Development Authority and the director of regulatory compliance of the Virginia Building Officials Association. As a state policy board, the Board of Housing and Community Development promulgates regulations related to housing, community development, building safety and fire prevention. These regulations include the Uniform Statewide Building Code, Statewide Fire Prevention Code, Virginia Certification Standards and Virginia Enterprise Zone Regulations.

The Board of Housing and Community Development holds elections annually at the first meeting of the fiscal year.
