    - 1. Owners unwilling to cooperate or participate in sale or mortgage
    - 2. Disputes over rights of occupancy
    - 3. Disputes over payment of real estate taxes, insurance and maintenance costs
    - 4. Smaller interests are less valuable but can still be disruptive
  - B. Identifying issues by determining the status of title
    - 1. Title examination (real estate records and will records)
    - 2. Family/ancestry investigations (death certificates, obituaries, familiarity)
