




Employment for GO Virginia Region 1, Four-Quarter Moving Average




Key Revenue Trends – Sales Taxes

EAST GATEWAY (421 PARK AVE.) - SITE STABILIZATION

A key component to the Physical Improvement Plan is the site stabilization of 421 Park Ave. This initiative seeks to address blight influences and promote investment by transforming the vacant lot from an eye sore into a prominent gateway to downtown. Proposed design strategies include a new sidewalk system, new gateway sign, and a landscaping easement along the north and east edges of the property. CDBG funds are slated to cover the installation of streetlights, a new gateway sign, and wayfinding signage. In addition, the City will match this effort by providing new sidewalks, street trees, a lawn area, and plantings for the proposed easement.





Figure 16: Overall Improvements at East Gateway.




Figure 17: Potential location and concept design for new East Gateway welcome sign.




Figure 12: Existing and Proposed Improvements on Park Ave.
